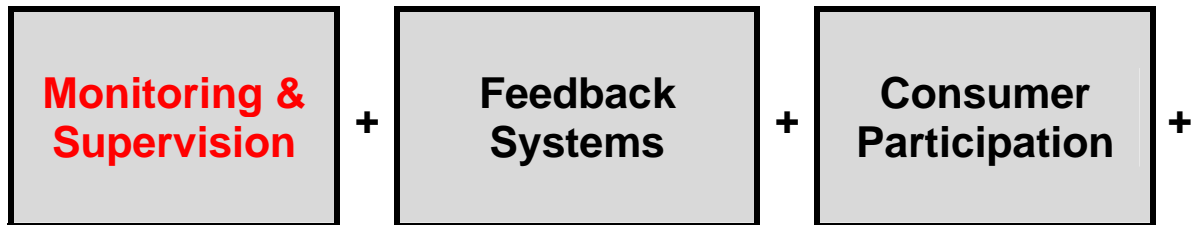
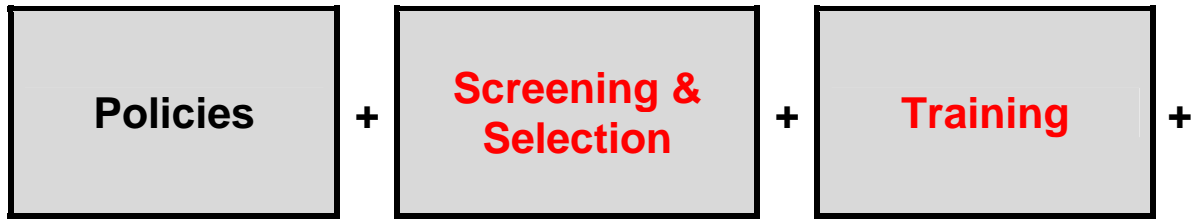

SCOPE OF THE PROBLEM IN PARKS

- 1 in 4 Girls
- 1 in 8 Boys
- 15% of School Children
- 300% Increase in peer-to-peer abuse
- 40-50% of incidents are perpetrated by adolescents
- 80% of abuse goes unreported
