EXHIBIT BOOTH LAYOUT SUBMISSION

ALL exhibitors must complete the Booth Layout Form online form by Friday, Sept. 17.

If your booth is 20'x20' (6.10m by 6.10m) and larger, displaying Inflatables, and/or you are requesting a variance to the [display rules](#), you must *ALSO* submit a drawing of the proposed booth layout to IAAPA for approval. Drawings must include a top, front, and side view of the exhibit and indicate all dimensions. Any exhibitor attempting to build a booth greater than 20'x20' without IAAPA approval will not be permitted to set-up or **will be forced to close** their space until the design has been approved. In addition, late design drawing submissions are subject to a fine and/or loss of seniority as outlined [here](#).

Please provide IAAPA 10 working days to review/approve your booth layout. Confirmation will be sent to the email provided on the form with approval or notating any corrections required. Please contact exhibitors@IAAPA.org with any questions or if you do not receive a confirmation of approval.

 - Your booth is located in the outdoor exhibits area
 - If you selected “yes” to the first question please upload up to two files of your booth layout. Diagrams should include top, front, and side views of your exhibit, and indicate all dimensions. **Please do not submit the form until your booth layout is ready to review.**
 - Click Choose File button.
 - Browse to the file on your computer and select/click Open.
 - Click the Upload File to make sure it attaches. File types accepted are PDF, GIF or JPG up to 10MB in size.
